In both cases it was only a couple of points away from the top two. Well done to all involved.

The District Athletics Trials are a chance for our athletes to shine in the hope of selection for the North West Surrey District team. This year, 14 of our athletes have been selected to represent the District in the Surrey School Championships next month. They are: Sophie Funnell (Shot), Orla Manchester (Discus), Tyla John (High Jump), Jasmine Keeley (200m), Fred Mitchell (800m), Adam Teale (300m), Freya Smith (Hurdles), Jack Mawer (Javelin), Tolu Ayo-Ojo (Triple Jump), Alex Hanson (200m), James Hanson (200m), Max Heyden (1500m), Callum Lowry (200m) and Hallam Webb (400m).

Tomlinscote took part in the **National Cup for Athletics** with some superb performances and school records being broken on the track and field. The Year 7/8 boys and girls and the Year 9/10 boys narrowly missed out on qualifying for the next round, however the Year 9/10 girls qualified for the South East Regional Final next month. Well done to all involved especially our older girls. Good luck in the Regional Final!
