

REVIEW OF THE TOMLINSCOTE WEEK



Excellent Value Added Achieved at GCSE

29th September 2017

Last week we highlighted the excellent GCSE results achieved by our Year 11 students and this week we have been informed that Tomlinscote has gained a superb value added score. We have gained a Progress 8 score of 0.27. This means that our Year 11 students gained approximately a quarter of a grade higher across each GCSE subject compared to other students of a similar prior attainment nationally. We are very pleased with this result and the students and staff should be very proud indeed.

Inter form Football and Netball

We have introduced an Inter form competition at Tomlinscote with one event every month. The winning form in each event gains 5 points, second place wins 3 points and third place gets 1 point. At the end of the year the winning form in each year group gains a reward.

The first event took place this week with Football and Netball. All the students participated well with a great deal of competitive spirit shown. Students enjoyed the opportunity to compete against their peers and the noise in the Sports Hall got very loud at times!
